Thus Public is forbidden to sit on the roads so that people have difficulty and scarcity in coming and going. In addition ,crimes and misdeeds also are in the markets and thus on the roads so sitting in such place I like wasting one's time and becoming a partner in crime. Offcourse its purpose s good, such as inviting good deeds to those who come and going and preventing them from doing evil, responding to salaam, avoiding harm, helping people etc. but there is also a special emphasis on eye protection.

(252) Respect and obedience towards parents

Parents are Allah Ta'ala's big gift, and are the cause of success in this world and in the hereafter. Obedience and obedience are justified on the basis of what the parents' order them do. It is a crime to do so. In the Qur'an and Hadith, good behavior and obedience is strongly urged and good behavior and obedience are prohibited. Treat your parents well, if one or both of them reach old age in front of you, don't even say "uff" to them, don't leave them and talk to them very politely.

Imam Kurtubi Rah. said that in this verse, Allah has made it obligatory for the parents to be polite and respectful and to treat them well with their worship, just as in Surah Luqman



(253) Respect towards Parents in the Light of Hadith

The Prophet Muhammad S.A.W. said that (1) The pleasure of Allah is in the consent of the parents and the displeasure of Allah is in the displeasure of the Parents. (2) The father is the middle gate of paradise whether you accept or ruin it. (3) one man asked to the Prophet S.A.W. that what is the right of parents on offsprings? The Prophet S.A.W. answered that they both are your paradise and hell. (means that their obedience and service leads you to paradise) (4) Allah Ta'ala forgives all the crimes except disobedience to parents. It's punishment given in the world before death. (5) The Prophet Muhammad S.A.W. answered three times that in the court of Allah is the big crime is o disobedience with parents.

Explanation is that it is necessary to service parents and obey the parents. It is necessary to make them happy and make comfortable. It is haram to make hurt them wth one's own false work. Infact it is not necessary to obey for non-permissible act. But with great humanity you should say no to them. Allah ta'ala give us insight to do the same. Ameen. (254) Sila Rahmi (kindness to relatives)

Allah has ordained on every people the rights of parents, children, wife and brother, sister as well as the rights of other relatives and neighbors and has commanded them to be granted and those who perform this according to Islamic teachings is called "Sila Rahmi" and it has been ordered in Shari'ah. And those who break the relation with relatives are called "Ka'atrahmi" (severer of kinship bonds) and it is revalation with the right of the servant of Allah.

There is also a great deal of urgency in the hadiths to show silarahmi (good behavior with relatives). It has been shown to be the cause of recognition of faith, barkah in livelihood and increase in age (longevity). In addition, it is said to be a hindrance to entertaining in paradise and accepting execution, who is merciful and deprived of the mercy of Allah.

The Prophet Muhammad S.A.W. (1) those who believe on Allah and the Day of Judgment, it is necessary to respect guest and make kind towards relatives. Talk good otherwise keep silent. (Bukhari Shareef 1/65)

- (2)A person who wants his livelihood to be enlarged and his life to be prolonged then he should be merciful.
- (3) Allah almighty says so the relative is friendly, whoever is merciful, I will get it (that is, I blessed with my kindness and compassion) and whoever is merciful (that is, he will sever ties with relatives) then I will also cut him off from me and merciful remove him.



(256) Sila Rahmi (the kindness towards relatives)

(In the lights of Hadith...2)

The Prophet Muhammad S.A.W. said that (4) Those who beak the relation with relatives can not enter in paradise. (5) On each and every Friday night all the execution of man are presented in the court of Allah. From those who break the relationship with relatives, Allah Ta'ala doesn't accept his execution. That means he didn't get reward for his execution.

- (6) It has been copied from Hazrat Abdullah Bin Awafa R.A. that Allah Ta'ala doesn't shower his mercy on people those who break the relationship with relatives.
- (7) Hazrat Anas R.A. said that Allah Ta'ala never saw such people who break the relationship with relatives or bad neighbor.

So you have to fulfill the rights of relatives unless they can't and you should treat them well even though they treat us badly. You have to be kind with relatives. And this entire he do only for the sake of Allah. Allah Ta'ala gives us insight to save from the crime of breaking relationship with relatives.

The virtue of Bismillah

Bismillah is the very blessed verse of Qur'an. Reciting before starting any work makes the work worthwhile and starting work without Bismillah does not make it worthwhile even if the work is completed. Gousul Aazam Shaikh A.Oadir Jilani has written that the **Prophet** Muhammad S.A.W. said that "If the name of my ummah is placed on he scales of execution, the weight of their virtues will be down with the blessings weighed Bismillah." And the Prophet Muhammad S.A.W. said that by reciting Bismillah before dua, that Dua is accepted And the Prophet Muhammad S.A.W. said that if the people of my ummah will recite Bismillah on the Day of Judgement, then the Weight of their virtues will become heavier.

The Prophet Muhammad S.A.W. said that (By the order of Allah) Bismillah is one who heals the sick, helps in medicine, enriches the poor, saves from the fire of hell, relives us from the hardships of the grave, Protect you from the torment of Hell, and save them from the disaster. (Gunyatuttalibin)

To empower the practices of Non-Muslim..1

Islam allows eating and drinking and pleasure in a lawful manner. But it is strictly forbidden in the shariah from acts which are similar to those of non-Muslim or acts did not even respond to the salutation of the person who acted against Shariah. (Tirmizi 104/2) Before Islam, in the two days of Meherzaan and Navroz, people used to celebrate in sports etc. but the Prophet Muhammad S.A.W. forbide it. (Mishkat: 126) It is stated in the Hadith that whoever resemblance with any other community then will be with them on the Day of Judgment. (Abu Dawood: 559)

The resemblance with Non-Muslim in every aspect of life like eating-drinking, living-doing workis very awful and it is clear from the Ahadith and companions that it is not permissible to act like non-Muslim on their festival. Most of the Aalim (Islamic Scholar) think this thing as much as bad that they said that whoever resemblance like non-Muslim are ordered them to be "Infidle" (kaafir). You have to protect yoursef by buying yhings on the occasion of their festival and protect yourselves from resembling them.

It has been written in **"Fatawa Jakhirah"** that one who leave house to enjoy the festival of non-Muslim (Holi,Kite-flying, cracker bursting, playing Garba or watching garba etc.) is near to "Infidelity" because he promotes the execution of the such work which leads to infidelity and proved himself that he does good work.

It has been written in the book "Umdatul Islam" that the one who follows the customs of Non-Muslim like for building house crack the coconut, tieing red thread etc then that person turns into infidel.(Mishkat 252/2, Mazahire haq- 3)

So involving the festival like Diwali, Makar Sankranti, Christmas etc. is equal to involving or get bust in the act that against Islam. It gets resemblance to infidel. By this act we get away from the Islamic values. It is haram. To reference to this Allah Ta'ala said that "there are some people who become the buyer of the things that leads them to away from Allah. And unknowingly they they get away from the Allah. And make funof him. This person gets torture that they humilates from others." (Surah Luqman verse-6, Aasan Tarjumaye Qur'an page no. 688) (continued....)



(266) To empower the practices of Non-Muslim

Wealth is the blessings of Allah ta'ala. Using this money in the activities that involved in crime is negligence of Allah ta'ala. It is false expenditure to buy the crackers and kite. And It is stated in Qur'an that "Make a trust that whoever expense in false things t the brother of satan." (Surah Bani Israil Verse 27) That it is not permissible to used the wealth in non permissible act. (Surah Ibrahim/7)

Now a days, we can see the signs of Qayamat like earthquake, battles, hassle and bussle, Accident, money crisis. So then the time has not came that we fear to Allah Ta'ala? It is stated in the Qur'an that "that time has not yet come that fear of Allah Ta'ala are not come to your heart and your heart are bending infront of Allah ta'ala and the deen of Allah Ta'ala?" (Surah Hadid/16)

So that's why your valuable time and wealth should not be used in non-useful things. You should protect yourselves in involving in the work that is non-permissible and should protect others also.

(267) Arrogance

Arrogance reality is that to exalt one self and despise others is the root of all evils and crimes. Anger, persecution, hatred, enmity, slander and dissension are often the result because difference arises only when each man considers himself superior to the other. If everyone's consider himself inferior then there will be no chance of disagreement and qurrel. | In short, Pride is the root of all evils and crimes, even kufr and shirk .Allah doesnot like the one who makes pride, the one who has the pride in heart equals to one mustard seed then he will not enter in paradise. The Prophet Muhammad S.A.W. said that those who make pride will not enter the paradise and nor one who understand one's superior. (Abu Dawood Sharif) Hazrat Abdullah Bn Abbas R.A. said that eat what you want, wear what you wish, But the law is that you don't have pride in your heart, and you won't expense more. (Bukhari sharif)



(268) Remedy for Arrogance

Sitting next to the poor, accepting their invitation, serving them, doing their deeds. (2) Even though there are servant and children one should brings the market of the house etc, himself and if possible he picks it himself. (3) Whether he recognize the people or not he should salute (Salam) every one. (4) He should not worry about defending and justifying himself by listening to his own gossip and evils. Etc. Buck should realize the evils within him and give thanks that very few of the evils within me have been revealed. (5) If he gets angry, he should apologize even to small person. (6) Be ready to believe any admonition and every word provided that it is against nature and not against sharihah. If you not get anything then somebody with else. Remembering death and attending funeral (janaza) whenever possible, take part in full ablution (gusl)

Punishment of Arrogance

(Ibne Majah) It means that both of them are my virtues, if there is a claimant over any of these two, that is, if he is arrogant then I will punish him.

It is narrated from Hazrat Abu Hurairah and Abu Khallad R.A. that the Prophet Muhammad S.A.W. said that when you see a servant in a such state that he has less love for world and he blessed by the virtue of Allah to protect his tongue from idle talk. Then stay in a company of such people because if servant has this state then he get wisdom from Allah.

To get wisdom is that he can understand each and every fact. And he speaks such a talk that which are true and beneficial. So this friendship has alchemy effect. In Qur'an Sharif it is stated that those who get wisdom, he get great goodness.

(Bukhari-Muslim) (9) For the man who wants to stop quarelling even though he is right, then he get house in the middle of the Paradise. And those who have good habits get a house on the top of paradise. (10) Give a gift to each other as it removes the bitterness of heart. (Makhjane Akhlaq)



The edifications of the Prophet Muhammad # (2)

(11) Don't be happy about your brothers problem, Allah will rest him and give you sorrow. (12) One man asked to the Prophet Muhammad S.A.W that what is crime? He answered that the thing that hurts heart and shakes heart. (Subhanallah how short and concise answer) (13) No gift is as good and big as Sabar (patience) (14) A man is in distress and keeps telling people (begging) that distress doesnot go away and whoever begs from Allah in his distress (poverty). (34) The goodness- virtue of human Islam is to give up non-beneficial deeds. (35) If a man gives encourage many for a good deed, he gets the same reward as the man who performs it and if a man who performs it. The meaning of this edification is that Protect your mouth to eat haram food. Save and see before eating that haram and suspicious food is not going in your mouth. If it is halal and culinary, eat it after reciting Bismillah and if it is haram or suspicious then protect it with your mouh so that it does not enter your stomach. It is a poison which destroys deen and faith.

So mohtaj is so much more important and necessary to take care of his rights and to go through the rights of people

(288) Ten means to get Taqwa (Piety and fear of Allah)

Hazrat Mujddid Alfesani Shaikh Ahmed Sarhind (Reh.) has considered **ten** things necessary to get *taqwa*. He said that taqwa will not be obtained until man makes these ten things necessary (inevitable).

(1) To protect the tongue from backbiting. (2) Avoiding wrong thoughts (slander) towards someone. (3) Keeping eyes closed from looking haram. (4) Speaking Truth (5) Protecting 5 times prayers. (6) Praising Allah in every situation, so that one's nafs (conscience) does not become arrogant (7) Avoiding ridicule. (8) Spending one's wealth in good deeds and avoiding spending one's wealth in the wrong way. (9) Never wishing the boasting for one's soul. (10) Firmly stick to creed of Ahle Sunnat wal Jamat. (★Ahle Sunnat wal Jamat are those people who have faith in the obedience of Allah and his messenger Prophet Muhammad and do respect of his Companion & along with the persuasion of Sunnah. This class is devoted to the middle class in Islam. *) (Maktubaate Imaam Rabbani-266 Maktub-66/2 Bahwala Taqwa aur uske Samraat)
